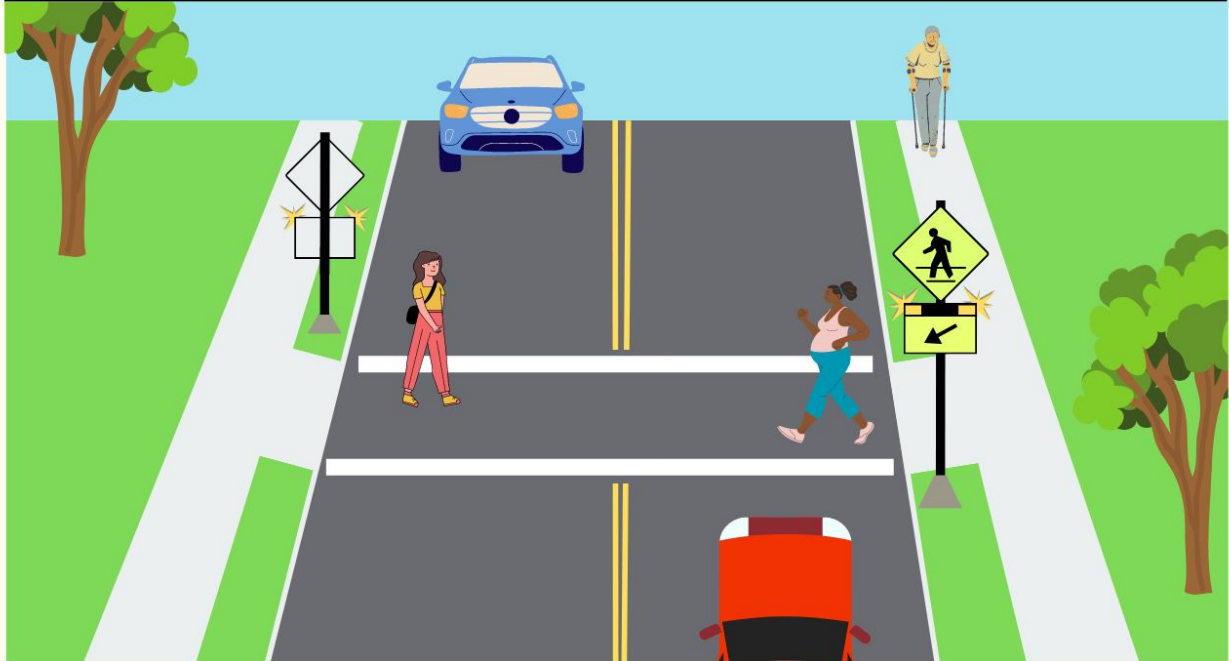


HOW TO USE AN RRFB

- RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACON -



Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB's) are devices that flash lights to alert drivers that pedestrians are crossing the road. RRFB's help increase safety and make it easier to cross the street!



PEDESTRIANS

- **PRESS THE BUTTON** to activate the RRFB lights, so that motorists are alert that you want to cross.
- **MAKE EYE CONTACT** with drivers and **WAIT** until traffic is yielding before stepping out.
- **CHECK TRAFFIC** to make sure each lane is clear before you move to the next.
- **CROSS THE STREET** while staying alert to your surroundings.

DRIVERS

- **WATCH FOR PEDESTRIANS** when approaching RRFBs and all crosswalks.
- **STOP FOR RRFB USERS**, even if the RRFB lights are not flashing.
- **GIVE PLENTY OF SPACE** by stopping before the crosswalk.
- **WAIT FOR PEDESTRIANS** to completely clear the crosswalk on your side of the road.
- **NEVER PASS** another vehicle that has stopped or is slowing down at a crosswalk.
